Dr. Fan Appointed to the National Endowment for the Arts Panel

On May 10th, 2021, Dr. Xiaoduo Fan was appointed to serve as a panelist of the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) grant programs. The NEA is the only arts funder in America - public or private - that provides access to the arts in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and U.S. territories. Each year, the NEA awards various grants to provide all Americans with diverse opportunities for arts participation. In this new role, Dr. Fan will join other panelists to recommend the applications which best represent artistic excellence and artistic merit. NEA makes its funding recommendations based on the results of the panel's review. These recommendations then go to the National Council on the Arts, a Presidentially appointed body, where they are reviewed in open session.
