RE: Updates: Clinical Research Operations and COVID19

As a follow-up to the communication issued on April 3nd, 2020, we are writing to once again remind faculty and staff that after March 19, human subjects-related research visits are restricted to those essential to a subject's well-being. **The reduction in activities has been extended and will remain in place through at least May 18, 2020.** We will continue to provide further guidance as more information becomes available.

Study teams are reminded to review the document *Joint Guidance from UMCCTS & UMMS COVID-19 Guidance for Investigators* (<u>https://www.umassmed.edu/ccts/covid-19/</u>) for additional updates.

Daily activity in the Clinical Research Center, including operation of outpatient clinics that utilize the space, is restricted at this time.

Office of Clinical Research Staff will be reviewing the OnCore Subject Visit detail report to determine what planned visits are to occur during this time period and will be reaching out as needed to study teams if it appears resources will be needed. **Please make sure all subject and visit detail is current in OnCore.**
