In follow-up to today's communication from Chancellor Collins and Dean Flotte, we are writing to advise you that after March 19, human subjects-related research visits will be restricted to those essential to a subject's well-being.

Additionally, we will limit daily activity in the Clinical Research Center, including operation of outpatient clinics that utilize the space.

The reduction in activities will remain in place through at least April 3, 2020. Further guidance will be provided on Monday and as more information becomes available.
