## Do you have COVID-19 symptoms?

Fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea NO Mask strongly recommended Stay off campus when on campus Take a rapid test **POSITIVE TEST NEGATIVE RAPID TEST** Consider repeat test 48 hours • Stay home later if symptoms persist Notify your manager Return to work when no fever for 24 Call EHS/SHS hours without medicine; no diarrhea, Return to work 5+ days after positive test and vomiting or cough when no fever for 24 hours without medicine: no diarrhea, vomiting or cough Must also wear a surgical, N95 or KN95 **Exposed to COVID-19?** mask days 6-10 Inform EHS/SHS **HIGH-RISK EXPOSURE** Don't take PCR test for 90 days Prolonged unmasked exposure or COVIDpositive person living in your home Work from home if possible. • If working from home is not possible, • take rapid test on day 3 and wear UMass Chan MEDICAL SCHOOL a surgical, N95 or KN95 mask through day 10. Test positive? See guidance above. Test negative? Continue wearing
