Application Specifics

General Information

- Interviews by invitation start on April 1st on a rolling basis
 No binding offers until June.
- <u>Start date</u>: July 1st (negotiable under certain circumstances)
- <u>Visa sponsorship</u>: J1 (and possibly H1b).

Application Requirements

- (1) Satisfy the following:
 - Applicants must have at least completed the requirements of an ACGME accredited general psychiatry residency at the time of start of the fellowship year.
 - Applicants must have a full Massachusetts medical license by the start date of fellowship.
 - o <u>GME Eligibility</u>
- (2) Documents to send:
 - o General application form
 - (AAPL application guidelines, common application checklist)
 - Three letters of recommendation (including one from the program director), sent directly from the individual who completed the letter.
 - Two redacted writing samples (preferably at least one forensic report, but could also include a discharge summary, admission assessment, or journal article)
 - Personal statement (one page)
 - USMLE scores, and USMLE certificate when applicable
 - Medical diploma
