1. Edit the block
2. Click on the settings tab
3. Copy and paste the appropriate text, from below, into the “CSS class name(s)..” field

# Overlay Text on top of Image

1. Create a new block: **Generic Block**
  2. Click on the Content Tab
    - a. [optional] Add a Title if you want one
    - b. Select your image
    - c. set Image Alignment to: left, right or center to set the alignment of your text over the image
      - i. leaving set to none will pick up default of "left"
    - d. [optional] add a Description
    - e. [optional] add Link Text and Link
  3. Click on the settings tab
    - a. Copy and paste the appropriate text, from below, into the "CSS class name(s).." field
