### **Provost and Dean's Updates**

Dr. Flotte gave some updates on some items:

- Lahey affiliation UMass Chan and Lahey Hospital & Medical Center have agreed to establish a regional medical campus, UMass Chan-Lahey, to be based at LHMC in Burlington, MA. This will house a new medical education program for students in the School of Medicine. A new research collaboration will also be formed, creating a new Institute for Healthcare Delivery Science and quantitative science research hub, to advance innovation in digital medicine, population health, and healthcare delivery. The first students will matriculate in the summer of 2024.
- Successful back to school students from all 3 schools are on campus. All three schools have their largest classes ever.
- Convocation events are the week of September 12<sup>th</sup>. Faculty are encouraged to attend.
