Chancellor Update

There are some areas that they'll be asking us to focus on. They noted our intense commitment to diversity. They were very impressed by the strategic plan and how much we have accomplished as a result of that. They are very confident in the financial well-being of the institution. Those were the big issues that were raised in the accreditation visit 10 years ago so they believed that we have addressed those very well.

I am grateful for the hundreds of members of the community who participated in this. Provost Flotte was instrumental, Dr. Larkin, who was in charge of the committee, Dr. Ahn was a superstar, and our Deans Lane and Vitello were outstanding. Vice Chancellor Marlina Duncan was a superstar. Thank you to Dr. Michael Kneeland and Ashton Gunn who did all of the behind-the-scenes work.

The team has 6 weeks to develop a draft of their report and we will have the chance to correct any factual errors. I will share the outcomes of the drafts and the action plan. We should all feel very proud of how the visit went.

This week, news of the 2022 Non-Unit Salary Increase Program came out. We wanted to let folks know that we recognize the impacts of inflation, and it was important for us to act. I have been pleased with the positive responses to this news.

We have revised the strategic plan. It now reflects that we have received a major gift and that we've added the sixth pillar which is a commitment to Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. We will continue to provide updates.
