Chancellor's Updates

Dr. Collins discussed the recent federal research funding cuts and delays to UMass Chan Medical School. The university led a multi-state lawsuit that was co-led by the Massachusetts Attorney General in February, concerning the NIH's proposed cap on indirect costs. The temporary restraining order was challenged, and then a permanent restraining order was put in place after the hearing. Unfortunately, the directs, the actual awarding of grants, study sections and council meetings are on hold, which is a serious problem for the medical school. However, we are all working together with the Provost and Deans of the three schools, and a tremendous amount of work has been done with our finance team in collaboration with the department chairs. Dr. Collins stated that we will work through these challenging times and hopefully come out on the other end with something that is sustainable and allows us to have a bright and successful future.
