#### Held grant since 2001

- Regional Medical Library, R7: New England States plus New York
- National Public Health Coordinating Office
- National Center for Data Services (w/ NYU Health Sciences Library)
- Year 5 of 5 starts May 1, 2025
  - Funding is approved waiting on Notice of Award to arrive
- Notified the RFP for next grant cycle will be delayed at least 1 year
  - Asked to make Year 5 funding stretch to cover gap year
    - Employ 10.5 FTE
