Preparation of 4% Paraformaldehyde in PBS (for ISH)

(Rivera lab)

Caution: Paraformaldehyde is highly toxic, avoid contact with skin, eyes or mucous membranes. Avoid breathing the powder during measuring and preparation.

- 1. Heat 90 ml of depc treated water to ~60 °C (can be put in 56 °C water bath).
- 2. Add 100 µl of 2 N NaOH.
- 3. Add 4.0 g of paraformaldehyde and stir.
- 4. Allow the solution to clear.
- 5. Add 10 ml of 10X PBS (depc treated)
- Allow the solution to reach room temperature and then adjust the pH to 7.4 with 1N HCl.
- 7. Filter using a 0.2 µm syringe filter.
- 8. Prepare 5 ml aliquots in polypropylene tubes and store at -20 °C.
